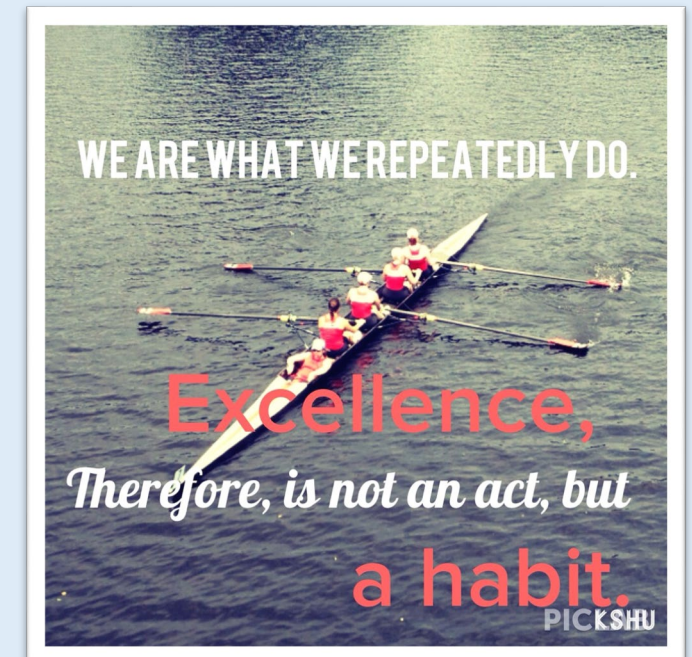
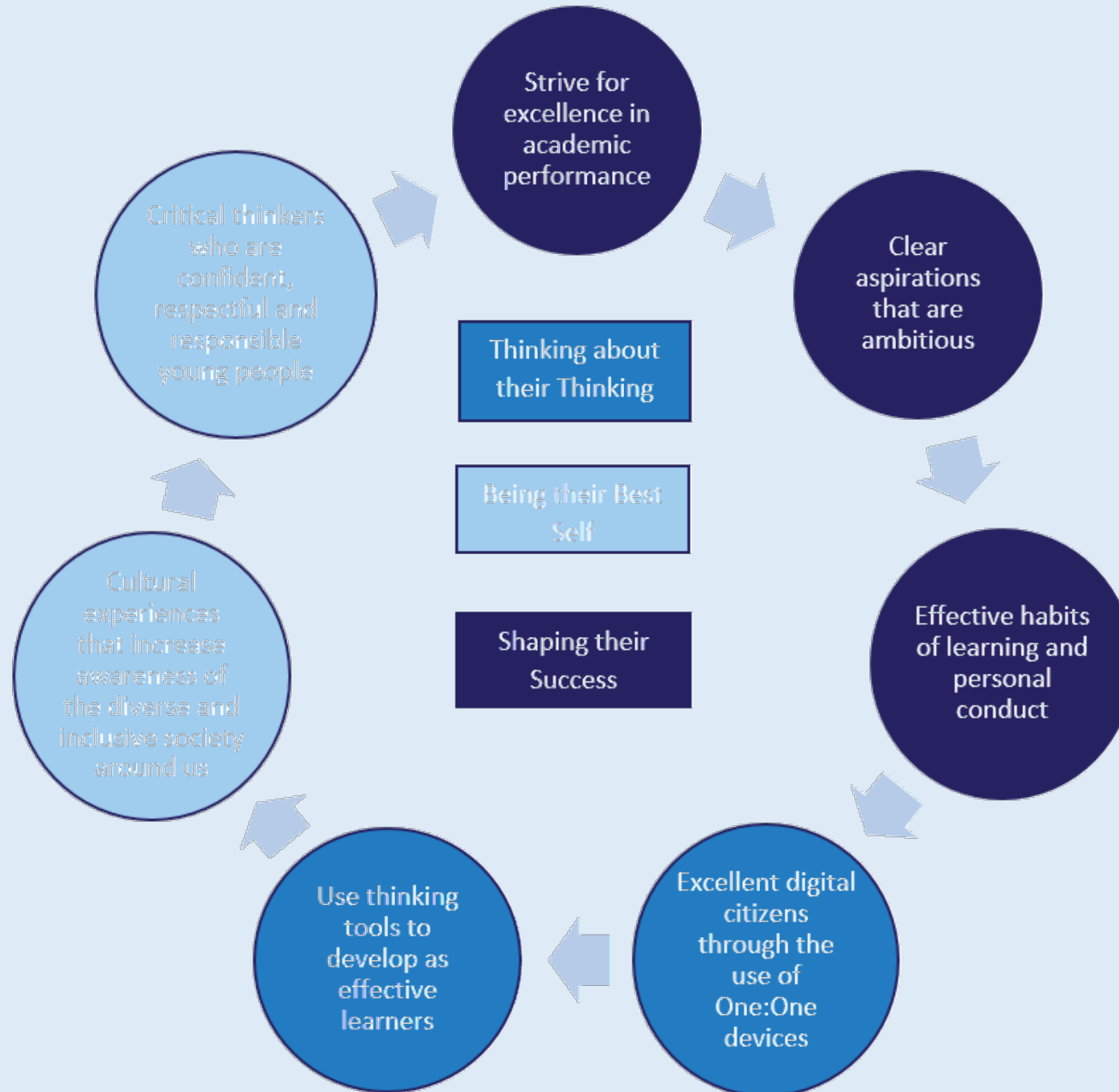

Students at the Maritime Academy will be united as a community to support each other to be their best selves.

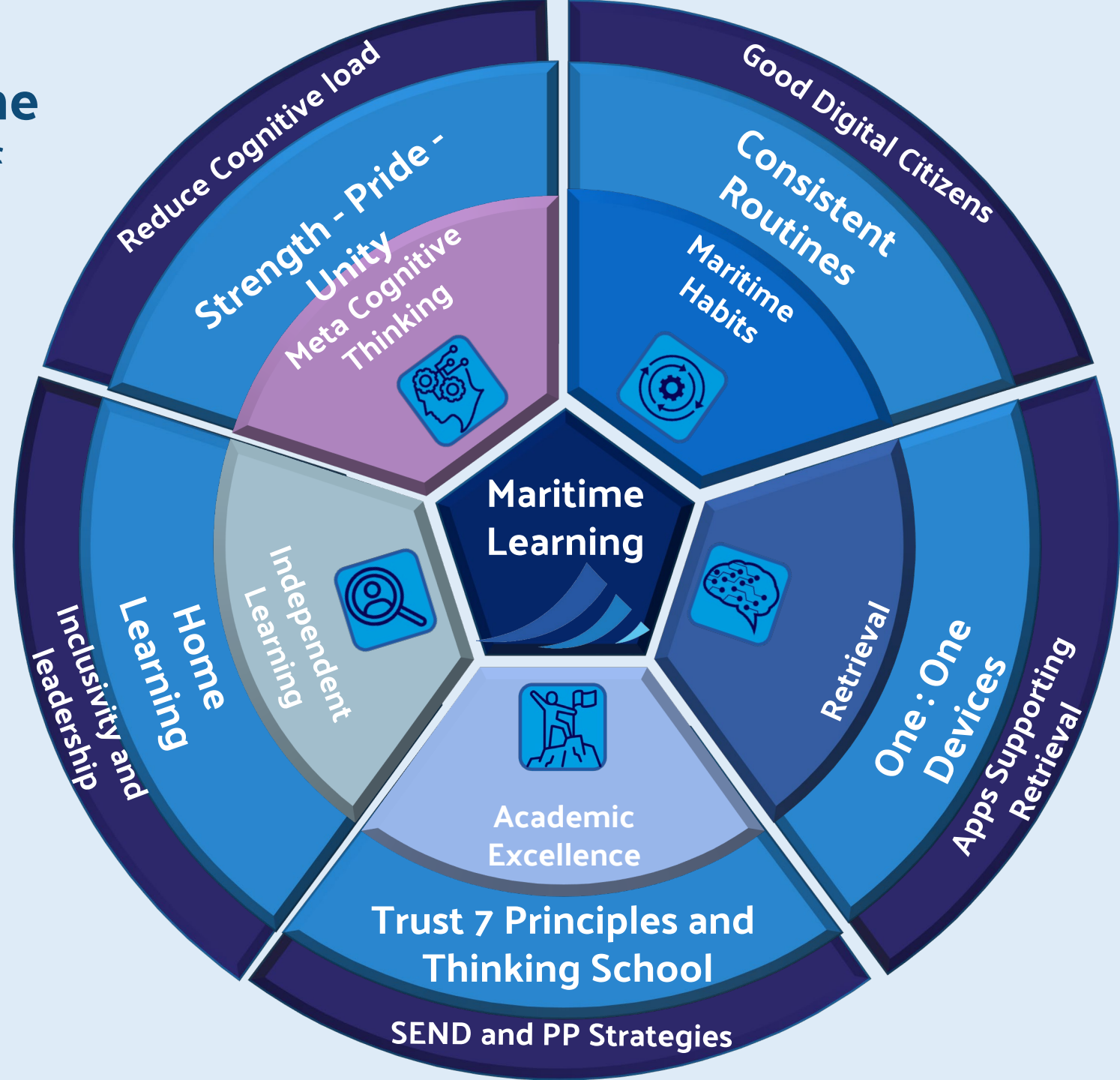
They will demonstrate respect for where they learn, who they learn with, and who they are as unique, aspirational young people.

At the **Maritime Academy** we believe that learning doesn't just happen within the classroom: it transcends the uniform and the textbook and stays with students long after they leave school.

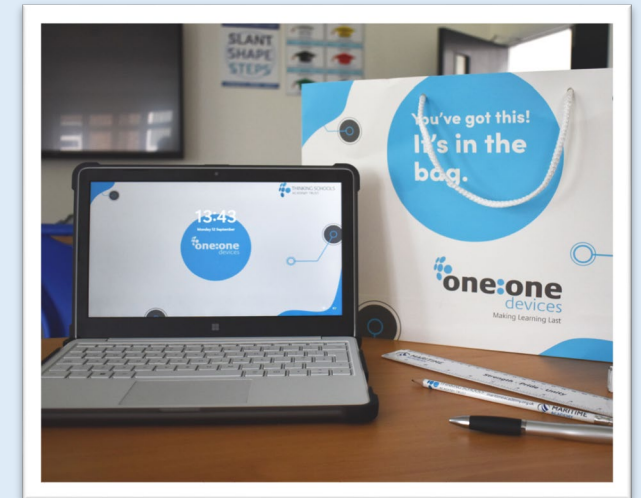
As a Thinking School, we are proud of our cognitive approach to education; we put an understanding of how the brain learns at the heart of all that we do.

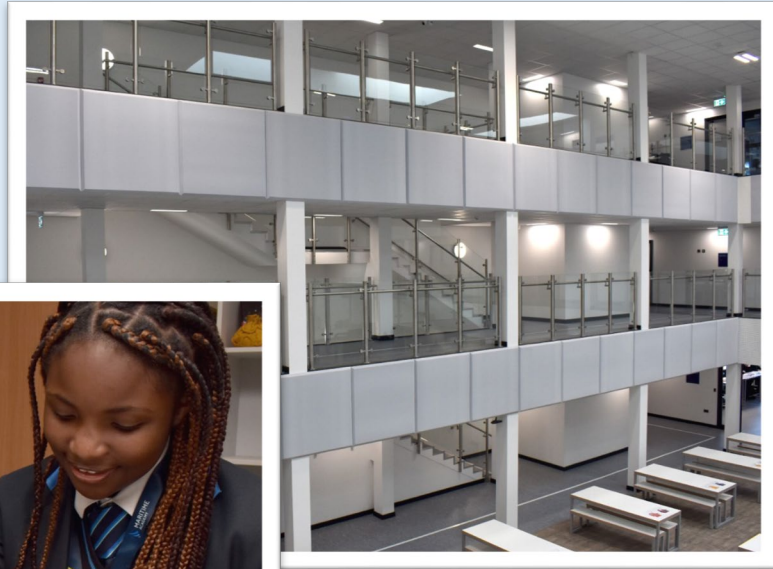

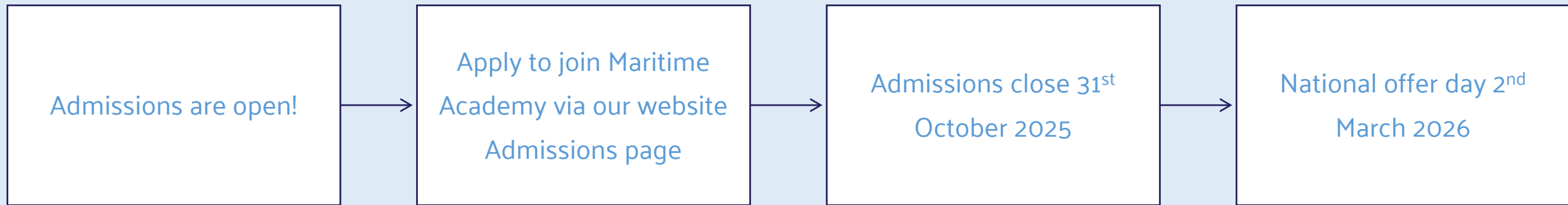
