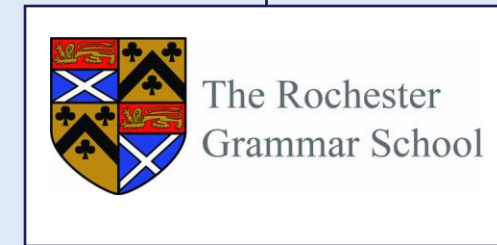
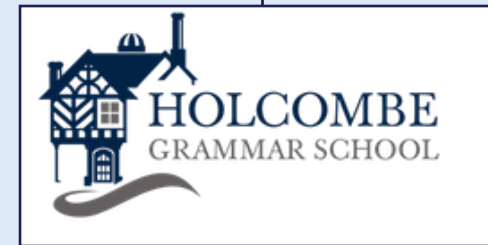

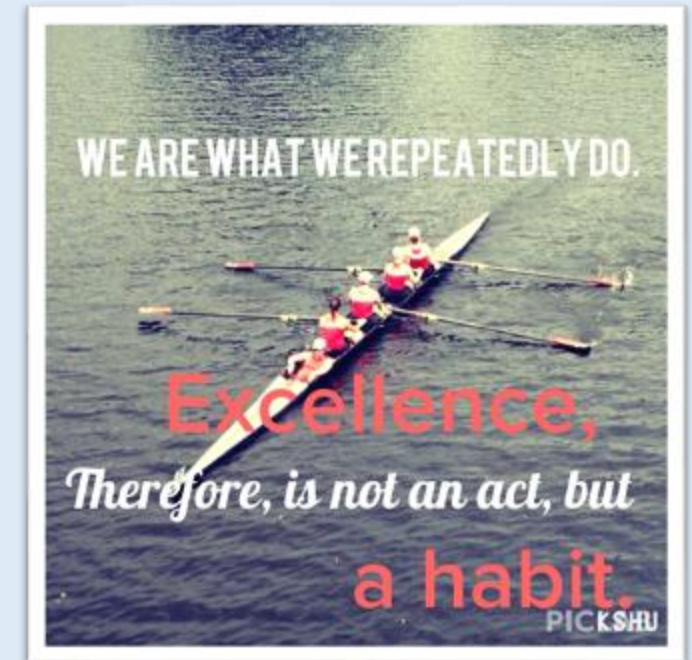
Students at the Maritime Academy will be united as a community to support each other to be their best selves.

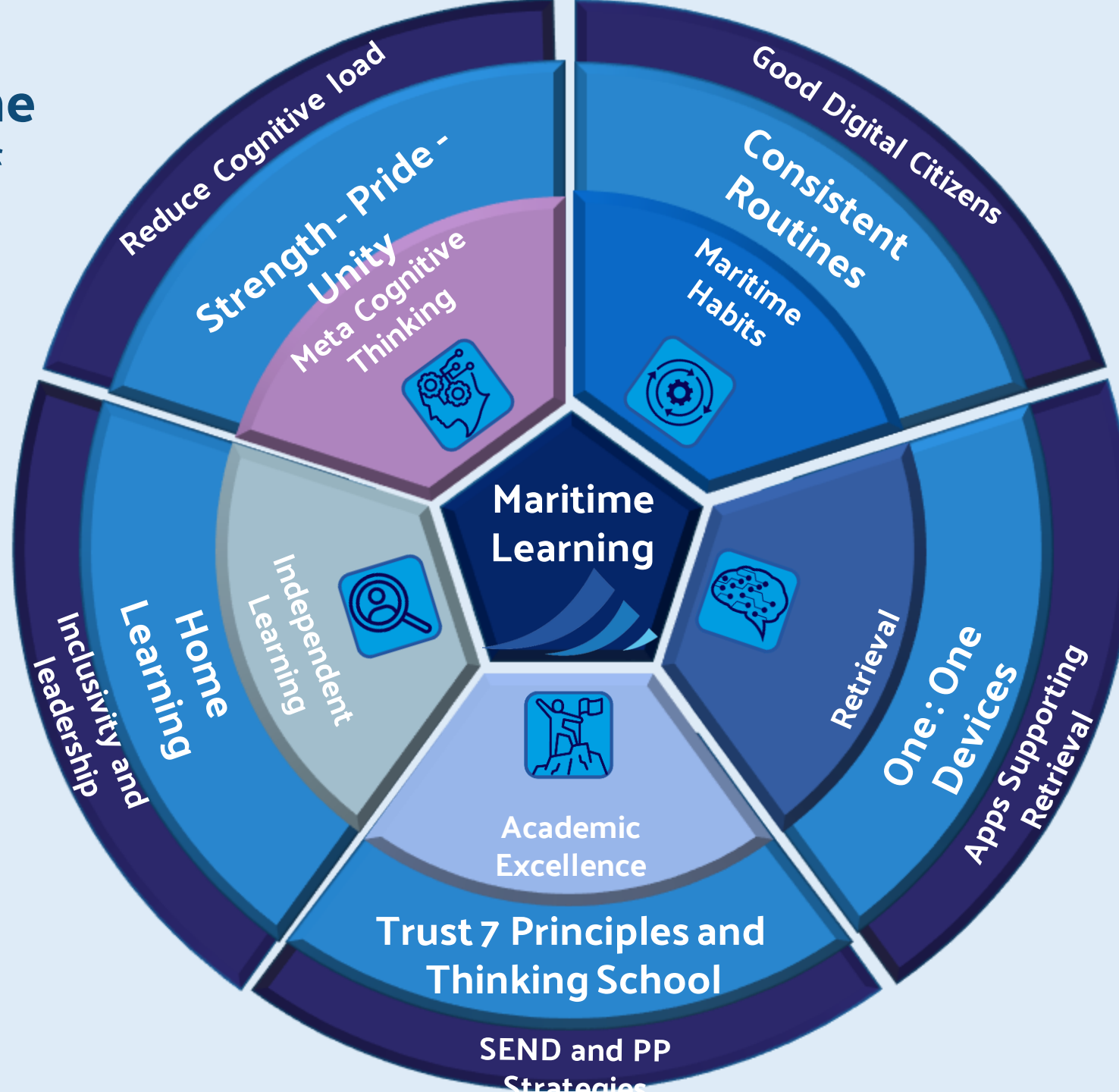

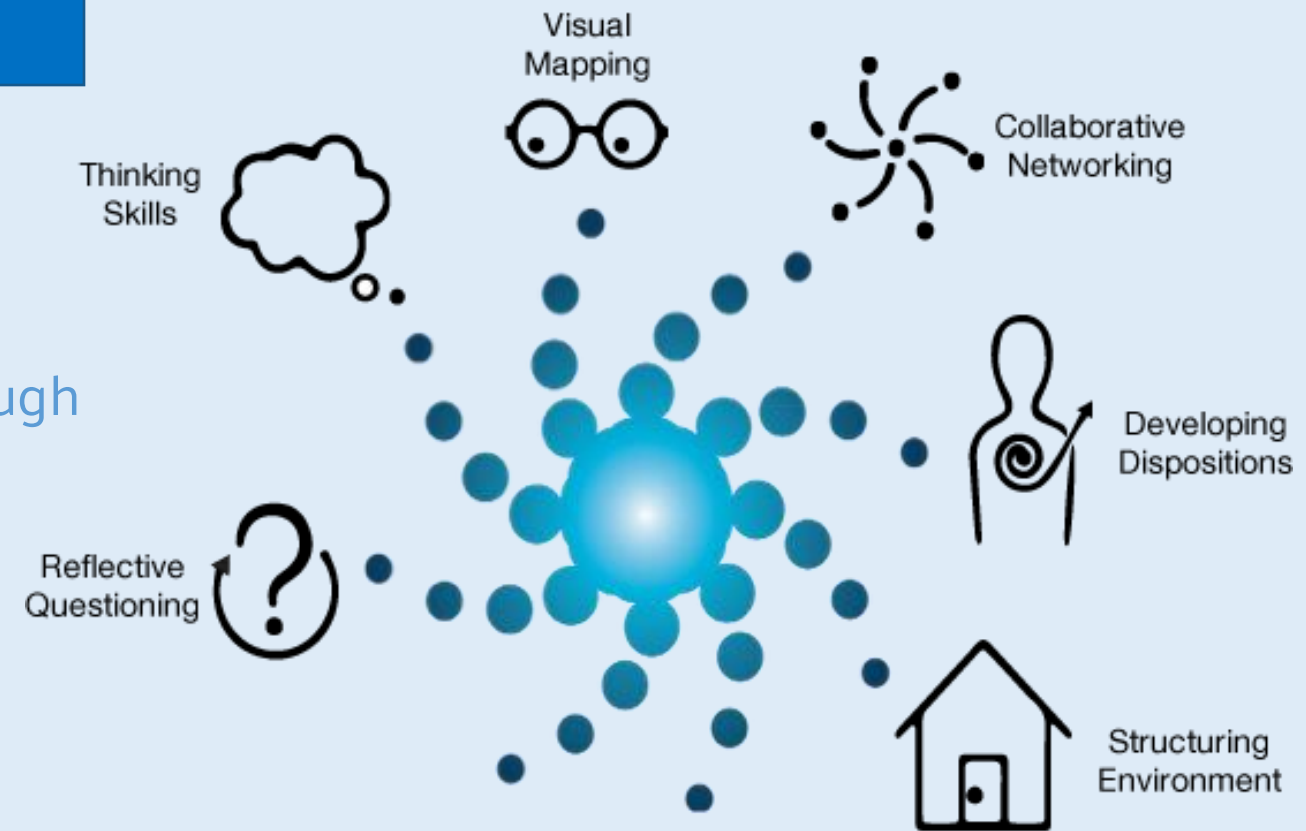

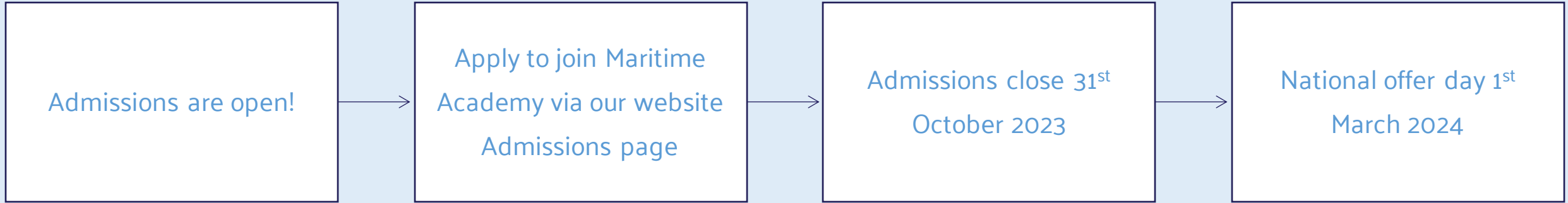
